Community and Student Care Worker (Residential Students)

The primary objectives of this part-time position are:

- Provide student care in individual and group settings to students at SMBC, with a particular focus on **residential students**.
- Work with management team and residential assistants to coordinate residential student placement, arrivals and departures.
- Identify and respond to residential student needs or issues that may arise in relation to accommodation or communal living.
- Develop opportunities for proactive pastoral care towards female residential students.
- Triage students to appropriate specialist mental health providers and/or other services as needs arise.
- Engage in regular college calendar events including orientation, graduation and community events.
- · Assist with prospective student interviews.
- Assist with Community and Student Care services under the direction of the Director of Community and Student Care, as required.

- Represent the College within the wider Christian community.
- Comply with SMBC WH&S, Privacy and other policies.
- Attend weekly Community Care Team meetings, and other meetings as required.

The successful candidate will:

- Be teachable, approachable and open to evaluation by students and peers.

- Possess sound time management skills and demonstrated capacity to manage multiple projects.

- Possess a current valid Working with Children Check and currency of Safe Ministry Training.

Knowledge/Skills/Experience required:

- Experience serving/working in church and/or student settings. Experience in cross-cultural mission an advantage, but not essential.
- Demonstrated experience in pastoral care and discipling.
- Demonstrated understanding of the specific pressures and pastoral concerns arising in a residential college setting.
- Demonstrated experience working collaboratively in teams.
- Willingness to annually affirm the SMBC doctrinal statement.
- Qualifications in theology and/or ministry.
- Training in counselling or mental health are desirable, or willingness to undertake further training in this area.
- Sound administration and organisational skills.
- Proven experience in problem solving and decision making.
